COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS - October 2020

- Council approved a \$1,000.00 sponsorship for the Rosthern Junior College 2020 Homecoming project.
- A grant application for Investing in Canada Infrastructure Program – COVID-19 Stream was submitted for \$280,000.00 worth of sidewalk removal and replacement in 2021.
- Mask wearing will be mandatory in the Jubilee Sports Centre except when participating in a sport on the ice surface.
- A Public Hearing for Zoning Bylaw Amendments held on October 19th. During the Regular Council meeting that followed the public meeting, Bylaw 2020-06, which was a bylaw to rezone the former medical clinic property to Mixed-Use District from Community Service District, was read a third time and passed and Bylaw 2020-07, a bylaw to add Cannabis Retail Stores to the Highway Commercial District and Cannabis Grow Operations to the Industrial District, was tabled until the next Council meeting.

- HMC Management will be providing a council orientation for the newly elected Mayor and Council on November 20th.
- The final report on the operations and governance review of the Town of Rosthern which was performed by HMC Management will be presented to Council and Administration on November 21st.
