COMPOST PICKUP and LARGE-ITEM PICKUP (residential)

Compost Pickup

Every Tuesday (starting May 7th until November 5th)

Compost materials may be placed in containers or plastic bags and must be at the curb prior to 7:00 a.m. Containers weighing over 50 pounds will NOT be picked up.

The following are acceptable compost materials:

- * grass clippings
- * garden waste
- * leaves
- * weeds
- *fruit and vegetable waste
- * sawdust
- * coffee grounds/filters
- * tea bags
- * eggshells

Branches must be in 3 - foot lengths.

A maximum of three (3) items can be placed at the curb for others to take the weekend preceding Large Item Pickup (giveaway weekend). As items are taken, you may replace with other items from your household to be picked up on Monday, April 29th.
