Council Highlights- June

Highways Land Purchase – council agreed to sell 2.6 acres of land to Ministry of Highways for \$2,625.00 per acre. This land abuts existing Parcel A owned by the Ministry.

Medical Clinic Lease – council agreed to facilitate leasing of a portion of the proposed new medical centre for a medical clinic. Details are still being finalized.

Tax Enforcement – In accordance with section 22(1) of *The Tax Enforcement Act*, the following property files will be forwarded to TAXservice for enforcement:

Special Occasion Permit Request – council approved a special occasion permit request for the Rosthern Agricultural Society on July 26, 27 and 28 for the annual fair.

Councillor Resignation – council accepted, with regret, the resignation of Councillor Donna Walton effective June 30, 2019. The Town has 6 months to hold a by-election. The date will be determined at the next regular council meeting.

Bylaws – Two bylaws to incur debt were passed. One for up to \$1,500,000.00 for the servicing of the North Service Road area and one for up to \$1,400,000.00 for the development of 12th Street and area.

Water Main Replacement – Due to the condition of the water main on 5th Avenue, council approved the replacement of this line this year.

Donation – a donation of \$100.00 was approved for Rosthern Junior College for its annual golf tournament.

Junior Fire Members – council approved two applications of junior members to the fire department.
