Mayor’s Comment:

2020! Another new year is upon us.

Again, the Town of Rosthern will see significant developments and projects unfolding throughout the year. Here are but 7 things to watch for:

1. This is the year when construction is completed and our new school is opened, and deconstruction of the old schools should commence.
2. The Town of Rosthern will commence ownership and programming for the Community Multi-purpose Centre.
3. Foundation and offsite construction has commenced for the new medical centre which will be built adjacent to our new 12th Street construction.
4. Major planning, development and budgeting considerations are underway to replace our aging water treatment plant. To this end, you may have recently noticed some exploratory geo-technical drilling work occurring at the existing water treatment site in advance of replacement.
5. Similar to the work done on 5th Avenue and 5th Street last year, another block or two of aged cast-iron water main will be replaced, location to be determined.
6. Sidewalk repair and replacement work will move forward in a more expedited manner.
7. This is the year when we should see Dairy Queen open in our town!

Later this year, there will be municipal elections in Saskatchewan. All elected positions around the council table become available to both existing and potential new participants.

Along with Town councillors, administration and staff, I’m confident in saying that 2020 will be another busy, exciting and challenging year as we continue to develop our community.
