Mayor's Message: Fresh water in - then out!

The Town of Rosthern's fresh water is an outstanding resource, one which we tend to take for granted. Our water is exceptionally high quality and requires minimal treatment from the time it leaves our well field to when we turn on the taps in our homes, offices and schools.

Then out! Waste water leaves our properties and ends up in the lagoon system east of Highway 11. Once flushed or let down drains, waste water finds its way through our sewer system and then on to a lift station.

Our new lift station and force main are up and running after years of planning and almost a year of construction. I recently had the opportunity to tour this new facility and was thoroughly impressed by the design, technical aspects and increased capacity compared to what is being replaced.

We intend to have an open house later this spring when the site is tidied up and 2nd Avenue opens. I'm quite sure you will be surprised at the extent of our 3.2 million dollar investment, an investment in waste water infrastructure which will serve our town well for many years to come.

9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Village of Laird Shop, 220 Main Street

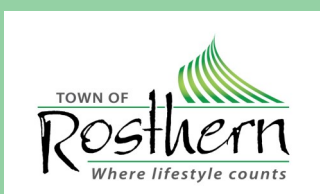
