At the SUMA conference earlier this year, we had the opportunity to listen to Doug Griffiths. Doug is an educator and has been involved in provincial politics but now writes and presents on community strengths and growth strategies.

Griffiths presents in an engaging manner and uses irony to hold his audience. His presentation was called 13 Ways to Kill Your Community and one point was titled "Don't Paint".

Doug stated: "Slow and painful destruction (of a town) can be summed up in two words: 'don't paint'. TOWN OF ROSTHERN ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT

The Council of the Town of Rosthern intends to adopt a bylaw under *the Planning and Development Act, 2007* to amend Bylaw No. 2008-08, known as the *Zoning Bylaw*.

The proposed bylaw amendment will:

- Add outdoor storage rental facilities, and associated development standards, as a discretionary use in the C2 – Highway Commercial District and the M – Industrial District;
- Add multiple unit dwellings, and associated development standards, as a discretionary use in the C2 – Highway Commercial District;
- Add restaurants, and associated development standards, as a permitted use in the M – Industrial District.
- Rezone from C2 – Highway Commercial District to MU – Mixed Use District Parcel A, Plan No. 101615712, Surface Parcel No. 149636414
