Animal Control

The purpose of animal control is to ensure the safety, health and welfare of our citizens and the protection of people and property in the Town of Rosthern. The Town has passed a bylaw to regulate and control the ownership and possession of animals within the Town and to ensure the humane treatment of animals.

All dogs and cats within the Town of Rosthern require an annual license, which expires at the end of the calendar year. You may apply at the Town Office for your license.
