- * An application to amend the Zoning Bylaw No. 2008-08 to rezone an area in Kestrel Court from R1 Low Density Residential to R2 Medium Density Residential was presented to Council. A public meeting was held Monday, March 6, 2023 to discuss this topic.

Bylaw 2023-02 Short-Term Borrowing was passed, resulting in the authorization to borrow from municipality's lending bank, if required.
