

December Council Highlights

- On December 15, Council held the scheduled Public Hearing for the Official Community Plan (OCP) and Zoning Bylaw. No submissions were received, so Council moved ahead with the second and third bylaw readings during the regular meeting that evening. Both bylaws were officially adopted and will now be sent to the Province for approval as required under *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*.
- Chrissie Engel joined the team as the Twin Rivers District Administrator on December 1, 2025, with a starting wage of \$27.59 per hour. Curious about the Twin Rivers District? Learn more about this collaborative partnership of municipalities on our website:

- For 2026, Western Municipal Consulting has been appointed to serve as the Town's Board of Revision, Development Appeals Board, and Municipal Appeals Board reviewers, and Wagner Inspection Services will act as the Town's building official in accordance with *The Construction Codes Act*.
- Council approved a payment to the Municipal Operations Manager for covering on-call shifts during the fall of 2025 due to staff vacancies.
- Update on New Water Treatment Plant Project:
 - Phase 1:** Construction of the water treatment plant is moving forward. The below-grade, multi-chamber concrete reservoir for treated water is now complete. The pre-designed steel building is being erected and underground waterline connection tie-ins are scheduled to begin mid in mid-January.
 - Phase 2:** The new, larger raw water supply line on the east side of Highway 11 has received all necessary permit approvals. Work on this phase is expected to start in mid-spring, weather permitting.
 - Phase 3:** Exploration for five new water wells is currently in progress. This is a variation of the original plan. The Town is also working to secure a road easement for the new supply line as part of this phase.
