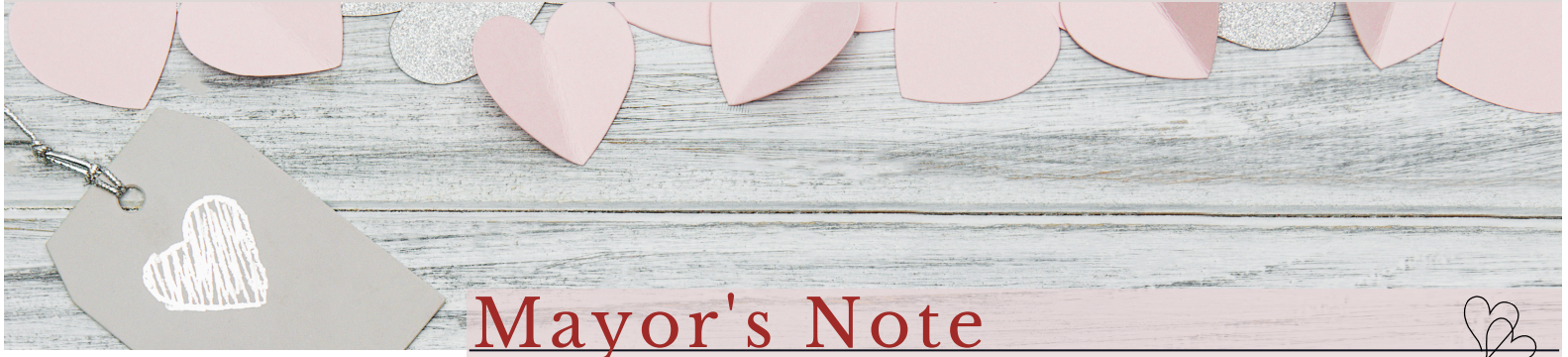





January Council Highlights

- 2026 Council Appointments to various committees and boards were made.
- On January 20, 2026 members of Council participated in the Virtual Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association (SUMA) Summit.
- The 2026 salary grid along with the related employee salaries were approved by Council. These adjustments follow positive performance evaluations completed at the end of 2025.
- Council approved a new weekday ice rental rate for the Jubilee Sports Centre.
- The Municipal Operations department was authorized by Council to proceed with repairs to a piece of equipment that was involved in an incident on January 5, 2026. This equipment is essential to the Town for the ongoing maintenance of various outdoor activities that are used heavily by the community.
