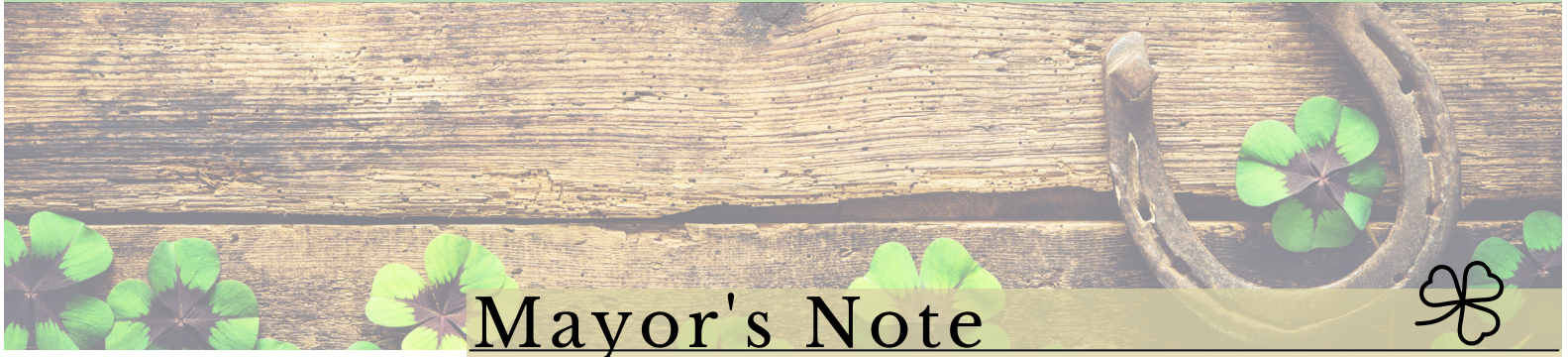

Rosthern Council and Administration continue to do our best to prepare for Rosthern's future. This means budgeting responsibly, preparing for upcoming costs, and occasionally working through short-term inconveniences.

The detour on 4th Avenue is all about getting Rosthern ready to provide fresh water for our citizens and to the many who come to Rosthern for essential services.


Our new Water Treatment Plant, along with an expanded reservoir of about one million gallons, will be supplied by a new, larger-diameter raw-water service line that replaces the original line feeding the existing plant. This upgraded line runs from the southeast corner of Highways 11 and 312, continues South along the East side of Highway 11, then turns West, crossing under the Highway, then railway, and down 11th Street before connecting to the new Water Treatment Plant.

The entire line is being installed using directional drilling, meaning no large open trenches are required. As a result, only a relatively minor detour is needed while this important work is being completed.



February Council Highlights



- Council approved the annual Short-Term Borrowing Bylaw. This bylaw may cover any temporary cash-flow needs required by the Town.
- Council also adopted a Debenture Transition Bylaw, which is required by the Municipal Financing Corporation to convert the Town's Shop's existing negotiable debenture into a non-negotiable one.
- Council has approved the consolidation of Lots 8, 9, and 10, Block 22, Plan F3625 Ext 0. The proposed consolidation meets all requirements of the Town's current Zoning Bylaw.
- The Town has agreed to support the formation of the regional Twin Rivers Group website and will contribute our share of the associated costs.
- Council approved sending two Public Works employees to the Saskatchewan Public Works Association Conference in Saskatoon. This annual training event helps staff maintain the education credits required for their certified water operator status.
- The Town hired Carleigh Peters as a term Finance Clerk.
- Approval was given for our Economic Development Officer to attend the Homestyles Home Show as a spectator, with the goal of promoting Rosthern and building connections with developers and other industry contacts.
- The Town has re-opened the second and third reading of both the Official Community Plan and the Zoning Bylaw to allow Administration to complete a few necessary map corrections to ensure they are fully accurate before they proceed to final approval and subsequent provincial review and approval. A new public hearing will be announced in the coming week.
