Mayor's Note

I'm interested in how Rosthern's Hospital history parallels our current new hospital project. Regional community collaboration, levies, fundraising, and advocacy to the Provincial Government, and financial challenges were very much at play then, as they are now. Our current hospital was opened in 1952 at a cost of \$197,592. A \$125,000 debenture was issued to help cover costs.

Fast-forward 75 years. Regarding our required municipal contribution to the new build, I was recently advised by Health Minister Cockrill that a change in provincial policy has reduced the municipal share from 20% to 10% of total capital cost. Along with our Twin Rivers neighbours and the Sask Valley Hospital Foundation, we wait for final new hospital cost estimates. For sure, this significant reduction will lessen the financial burden in our municipality.

We will continue to ask for and present more information as it becomes available.

March Council Highlights

- The Town's annual audit took place on February 26th. The Auditor is currently in the process of reviewing, and finalization will take place in a couple of weeks.
- The Town entered into a three-year agreement with Taxervice to manage the properties that are in tax arrears.
- The Town has renewed its lease agreement with Canada Post Corporation for a five-year term, covering the period from 2027 to 2032.
- Annual Town memberships with the following organizations were renewed:
 - Canadian Association of Municipal Administrators
 - Urban Municipal Administrator's Association of SK
 - Federation of Canadian Municipalities
 - Heritage Saskatchewan
 - Rosthern & District Chamber of Commerce
 - Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council
 - Twin Rivers Planning Commission
 - Saskatoon Regional Economic Development Authority
 - Solid Waste Association of North America
 - Saskatchewan Association of Fire Chiefs
 - North Central Transportation Planning Committee
- Members of Council, along with the Town's Economic Development Officer, will attend the Saskatoon Regional Economic Development Authority (SREDA) State of the Economy Summit in mid-May.
- Capital and operating budget meetings took place over the evenings of March 30 to April 1. The final budget is anticipated to be passed at the April 7th Council meeting.
- The Town has entered into a one-year agreement with the Town of Duck Lake to contract the services of our Animal Control Officer.
- Council approved entering into a Household Hazardous Waste Day agreement with other Twin Rivers municipalities, along with participating in updating the Twin Rivers District Plan, with project costs shared equally among the participating municipalities.
- Council approved 2 new members to the Rosthern Fire and Rescue department.
- The 2026 Assessment Roll opened on March 20 and will close on April 20, 2026. Not all property owners received a notice, only those affected by a change. If you have questions about a notice you received, please contact the Town Office.

Did You Know? In 2025, the Town spent more than \$234,000 on electricity to operate municipal facilities, water and sewer services, recreation spaces, and streetlights. An additional \$58,000 was spent on facility energy costs, bringing the total investment to nearly \$300,000 to support essential services and community facilities.
