I, along with Councillor Aebig, recently attended the annual Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council Convention, in Saskatoon. This convention sets a very solid agenda. Keynotes this year included: economist Mark Anielski speaking on “discovering ... Genuine Happiness Through Circular Economies” and U of S Chemistry professor, Lee Wilson spoke about his teams research into developing new plastics from plant based materials. The huge benefit of this “green chemistry” is the ability of these plastics to completely bio-degrade at the end of their life cycle.

Other agenda is more directly related to our Town’s solid waste management services. Rosthern is keeping up with changes on how recyclables will be collected in the next few years. Responsibility for recycling costs are increasingly being transferred to the businesses using recyclables to package their products. An opportunity was also provided to municipal attendees to learn of best practices and challenges in their communities. Several communities were curious to know more about our annual “large item pick up day” . The heavy usage of our SARCAN depot where many other items besides used cans and bottles can be dropped off was highlighted. Our Household Hazardous Waste Day was also noted as an important event for our community and Region.

May Council Highlights

- The 2025 annual drinking water quality and compliance report was reviewed by Council. This report is available for public viewing at www.rostthern.com and Town Office bulletin Board.
- Council approved a discretionary use application to allow the relocation of a cannabis retail store within the Highway Commercial District, subject to provincial regulations.
- Council proclaimed May 17-23, 2026 as National Public Works Week, recognizing the contributions of public works staff in maintaining community infrastructure and services.
- Updates to the Official Community Plan (OCP) and Zoning Bylaw were adopted. These documents will now be submitted to the province for approval accordance with *The Planning and Development Act, 2007*, helping guide future growth and development in the community.
- The 2026 Mill Rate Factor and Base Tax Bylaw, establishing the framework for this year's municipal property taxes, was passed by Council.
- Council awarded contracts for several municipal services:
 - A three-year contract for HVAC maintenance services for all municipal facilities was awarded to Ainsworth, totaling approximately \$48,600.00 for the term from June 1, 2026, to May 31, 2029.
 - A two-year contract for weed spraying, vegetation control, and fertilizer application services within municipal boundaries and designated areas was awarded to Steven Heatwole, totaling approximately \$28,500.00 for the term June 1, 2026, to October 31, 2027.
- 2026 seasonal staff for the Valley Aquatic Centre have been hired, and Jayme Lachance has been hired as full-time Parks and Recreation Operator starting May 11, 2026.
- The Town is contributing \$5,000.00 toward Valley Regional Park's pipeline mapping project along the Highway 11 corridor, as Town waterlines run parallel to this infrastructure and improved mapping will help prevent future service disruptions.
- Council approved Municipal Operations staff to install marker posts at the corners of the historic cemetery burial area to help clearly identify and respectfully preserve the site.
