Mayor's Note

A significant threat is approaching Rosthern. Our many American elm trees are at risk of being impacted by Dutch Elm Disease (DED). Communities in eastern Saskatchewan are already dealing with this issue, and infected trees have now been identified in Saskatoon and Wakaw.

Your Council and administration are taking this threat very seriously and are taking the following actions:

- This summer, we will complete a comprehensive inventory and mapping of our urban forest. This work will document species composition, condition, size, and spatial distribution across public lands. It will also help identify structural and forest health concerns, including DED, so that future decisions are guided by accurate, evidence-based information.
- Any elm trees, on public or private land, found to be infected must be promptly removed and properly disposed of to prevent the disease from spreading. Once infected, a mature elm can decline rapidly and may die within two weeks. Unfortunately, there are no effective pruning or treatment options once a tree is infected.
- We will continue our annual tree pruning program, as well as removal when necessary and replanting with appropriate tree species.
- We will prioritize sharing information on how residents can help keep our elm trees healthy. If you have questions or wish to report a tree health concern, please contact the Town Office or visit our website: <https://rosthern.com/plantingbeautification>

Important Reminders: In Saskatchewan, pruning elm trees is prohibited from April 1 to August 31. It is also illegal to transport, store, or purchase elm firewood.

Our goal is to minimize risk and loss, and to keep our vital urban forest strong and healthy in the face of this serious threat.

June Council Highlights

- The 2025 Audited Financial statement for the Town, prepared by Jensen Stromberg, was approved by Council.
- Several summer seasonal positions were filled for the Summer Program and Summer Students.
- Council approved a display table at the Family Medicine Residents Career Fair as part of efforts to attract future family physicians to the Town.
- Council authorized TAXservice to proceed under The Tax Enforcement Act to:
 - acquire title to two properties in the community due to unpaid taxes.
 - commence proceedings to request title for three properties due to unpaid taxes.
- Approval was given by Council to install a double-check valve assembly at Valley Regional Park, to be fully funded by the Park, to help safeguard the Town's drinking water system.
- Council proclaimed July 19 to 25, 2026, as National Drowning Prevention Week in the Town of Rosthern.
- Two Council members and one staff member were authorized to attend the Back to Batoche Opening Ceremonies on July 17, 2026, as invited guests.
- Council endorsed an application to the Growing Canada's Community Canopies program grant to support tree planting and canopy renewal in Rosthern.
- Spring Hockey concluded in mid-May, and the Jubilee Sports Centre has since been thoroughly cleaned and readied for the 2026–2027 season.
