August brings another round of harvest from gardens and prairie fields. It also marks the beginning of the annual bird migration to points south. In the first days of August, Sandhill Cranes can be seen and heard, as they begin migrating south to Florida, northern Mexico and Cuba. This is always something of a sad reminder that summer is ending and autumn is underway.

Just a few months ago in the May newsletter, I noted that several of us were beginning our annual, month-long bird count. This year, we were able to identify 152 species of birds in and close by Rosthern. One notable bird was a Common Loon which was content to stay on our town reservoir for about a week.

For myself and many other Rosthern citizens, having an awareness of our local flora and fauna is an important part of living in Rosthern. Let me know what you have been seeing!

July Council Highlights

- Council approved two lot consolidation applications, allowing property owners to combine adjacent lots to support development projects that span both lots and to ensure compliance with National Building Code requirements.
- Mayor Helmuth was reappointed to the North Central Transportation Planning Committee for the remainder of 2026 following the passing of the committee's previous municipal appointee.

Around your Municipal Office:

- Council and administration are continuing their review of the updated Traffic Bylaw prior to bringing forward a modernized version for adoption.
- Municipal Operations staff have painted parking lines on several streets to help address ongoing parking concerns. This cost-effective initiative is intended to improve traffic flow, encourage safer driving and parking practices, and support enforcement efforts by the Community Safety Officer.
