- All parking spaces on 6th street were full. Shops were busy or very busy, including our favourite ice cream venue, Lil Bean.



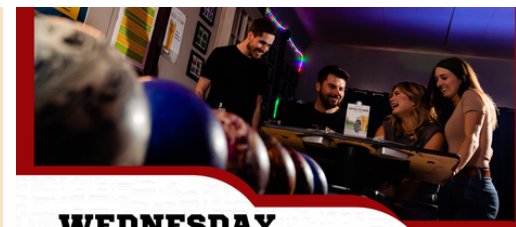

# August Council Highlights

- Council approved a lot consolidation application, allowing a property owner to combine adjacent lots to support the construction of a new home.
- Several Human Resources policies were updated to ensure they remain current, clear, and compliant with legislation. Council also updated the Recreation Program Refund Policy to the Town's new policy format and adopted new policies related to Information Security and Waterworks Rates.
- Council approved several requests related to the Harvest Festival taking place on September 19, 2026, including:
  - the temporary closure of 6th Street;
  - permission for the Station Arts Centre to serve liquor at the Jubilee Sports Centre during the event; and
  - complimentary Transit Service to help residents and visitors travel to and from festival activities.
- The Mayor and members of Council were authorized to attend various activities associated with the 150th Commemoration of Treaty 6, taking place August 20 to 23, 2026, at Fort Carlton.
- With favourable summer weather and staff availability, Council approved extending the Valley Aquatic Centre's operating season by one additional week.
- Council approved unforeseen repairs to the Town's John Deere tractor to keep essential municipal equipment in service, with costs funded through general operating funds.
- Through the second intake of the Town's Donation and Grant Policy, the Rosthern Fr. NBA Program was awarded a \$500 grant to help offset facility rental costs.
- Council approved the Town's 2025 Report on Municipal Waterworks, which was submitted to the provincial government, and reviewed the List of Lands in Arrears as part of the annual tax enforcement process.
- Attendance was approved for up to 3 members of Council at the 2nd Annual Business Forum on October 6, 2026, helping strengthen regional partnerships and support economic development opportunities for the community.
- Update on New Water Treatment Plant Project:
  - Phase I: The new Water Treatment Plant has entered the testing and commissioning stage. Crews are completing water quality testing and verifying that pumps, treatment systems, and distribution equipment are operating as designed. Epoxy flooring installation is scheduled for early September, with distribution system testing expected to begin later in the month as the facility moves closer to full operation.  
\*Stay tuned for Open House Details!
  - Phase 2: Construction of the new 2.2 km raw water supply line east of Highway 11 has been completed, marking an important milestone for the project.
  - Phase 3: Construction of five new water wells, a pumphouse, and supply lines remains the final outstanding phase of the project. The Town continues to work with the RM of Duck Lake to secure a road easement required for a portion of the new supply line.

Once complete, the project will strengthen the reliability and long-term capacity of the Town's locally supplied drinking water system.
