



## November Council Highlights

- November 19, 2024 was the first official meeting of the new Council. All of the Council was sworn in through an oath.
- Council acknowledged the Statement of Results from the November 13th General Election. Once again, we thank all residents who came out and completed their democratic right to vote.
- The following donations were approved:
  - Duck Lake Legion , 2024-25 Annual Poppy Campaign ( \$200.00)
  - Good Neighbours Food Centre, Purchased 5 Christmas Hampers (\$500.00)
  - U7 Rosthern Wheat Kings, Tournament Event, December 1, 2024 (\$170.10)
- Council has reviewed and agreed to enter into a new three-year Mutual Aid agreement with Twin Rivers District Municipalities.
- Annual acknowledgements of the Council's public disclosure statements were recognized. This acknowledgement along with various other financial disclosures are required to be submitted annually to the provincial government to ensure the Town receives a municipal revenue sharing grant from the province. This grant is based upon the population; in 2024, Rosthern will receive \$506,496. This grant provides predictable, no-strings-attached funding that is based on three-quarters of one point of PST revenue from two years prior.
- The 2024-25 season concession lease at the Jubilee Sports Centre has been awarded to Debbie Rae.
