January Council Highlights

- The Town has received a grant from SGI's Provincial Traffic Safety Fund for two other digital speed control signs.
- Tammy Tyrrell has been hired as the new Animal Control Officer starting January 16, 2024.
- Appointments to various Committees and Boards were made.
- Jensen Stromberg was appointed the Town's auditor to review the 2023 fiscal year.
- Council passed the following amended and new policies:
 - Purchasing Policy
 - Overtime & Banked Hours Policy
- Nicole Lerat Municipal Consulting has been contracted to assist with various large Town projects from January 1 to December 31, 2024.
- Town staff representatives will meet with the surrounding participating Municipalities to start the Regional Emergency Measures Organization Committee to establish emergency plans and programs for each municipality.
- Council approved the 2% increase for the employee's salary grid.
- Capital and Operating Budget meetings are ongoing.
