Mayor's Note

On Friday, June 28, a major announcement was unveiled for our Town of Rosthern! Infrastructure Canada and the Province of Saskatchewan announced that our Town has been approved to receive Federal and Provincial funding to commence work on extensive freshwater infrastructure upgrades. Total project costs will be approximately 19.6 million dollars, with Federal funds of \$7,843,152, Provincial funds of \$6,535,306, and a Municipal share of \$5,229,422.

Some items included in this upgrade are:

- new water supply and treatment plant,
- major increase in water reservoir storage capacity
- five new water wells,
- upgrade existing well-control buildings,
- a water plant and pump backup generator, and
- demolition of the old water treatment plant.

This is an exciting improvement to our freshwater infrastructure and is crucial for our communities future. Increased and efficient production, treatment, and storage capacity will enable the Town to accommodate current demand, ensure adequate water supply for emergency scenarios, and accommodate our ever-demanding future growth. We are delighted to have been selected for this project and look forward to project development and completion along with our Provincial and Federal partners.

- Grass Clippings
- Garden Waste, Leaves and Weeds
- Fruit and Vegetable Waste
- Sawdust, Coffee Grounds and Filters
- Tea Bags
- Egg Shells
- Branches - Must be in 3 - foot lengths

Compost materials may be placed in containers or plastic bags (do not tie) and must be at the curb **prior to 7:00 a.m.** Containers weighing over 50 pounds will **NOT** be picked up

Fire Safety Tips from the Fire Department

Summer is here! Here are some safety tips to ensure it's a great grilling season:



- Place the BBQ at least a 3 meters distance from your home or other structures and out from under eaves and overhanging branches.
- Make sure your grill is located on a flat, level surface.
- Keep the BBQ away from paths of travel and play areas.
- Use long-handled utensils to keep a safe distance from heat and flames.
- When a BBQ is in use, never leave it unattended.
- Keep children and pets away from the BBQ.
- Ensure the BBQ is fully cooled off before covering or storing away.
- If possible, have a portable residential fire extinguisher nearby.



June Council Highlights

- The 2023 Audited Financial statement for the Town, prepared by Jensen Stromberg, was approved by Council.
- The Public Hearing was held on June 3rd for the amendments of the Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw No. 2008-08. No written or verbal submissions for or against the amendments were raised.
- The second and third readings to amend the Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw No. 2008-08 to rezone an area north of the Sask Valley Medical Clinic from FUD – Future Urban Development to R2 – Medium Density Residential were passed.
- Council reviewed and passed the Community Standards Bylaw No. 2024-07. This repealed past bylaws: Nuisance Abatement Bylaw 2006-01, Noise Bylaw 2012-01, and Maintenance and Occupancy Bylaw 2006-04.
- Council amended the 2024 appointments due to a staff resignation and hiring and the remaining meeting dates for the Committee of the Whole meetings. Starting July 15th, these meetings will be scheduled before each Regular Council meeting.
- The Council Procedures Bylaw was amended to reflect the start time of the Regular Council meetings. Starting July 15th, Regular Council meetings will commence at 7:30 p.m.
- The remaining summer students for the Summer Program and Municipal Operations were hired for the 2024 season.
- Ryker Seesequasis was approved as a Junior member of the Rosthern Fire and Rescue Department.
- The MCC Clothes Basket was approved to close the 2000 block of 6th Street for a Family Festival.
- A sponsorship of \$1,000.00 was approved for the Sask Valley Vipers' Provincial Ball Tournament being held July 19 to 21.

On May 24th, we have opened the doors of the new "GNFC Food Market" modelled as a (free store) and on June 20th, we celebrated our grand opening with a program, a few short speeches, a tour, cake and coffee! The response from clients using our new and improved model for food distribution, has been extremely positive! Over the past 4 weeks, the number of families arriving for food support has increased dramatically. We have given food aid to 236 families over this time period, with 21 new families seeking food aid! Our food supplies are draining quickly and we continue to really need donations of both food and money to keep up with this need. We appreciate every donation of food and money!

We have a locked 'Shred-It' Bin situated at GNFC until August 31. People can bring their confidential, sensitive papers/documents to GNFC, placing them in the bin, where they will be shredded and securely disposed of. The cost for this is 'by donation' with all proceeds going to GNFC.
