### Mayor's Note

With Councillors Emily Hand, and Colin Aebig, I recently attended the annual Saskatchewan Waste Reduction Council's annual convention held this year in Saskatoon.

This convention presented a variety of information about what we buy, consume, repurpose properly, or not. Some positive examples; in Saskatchewan, since 2021, 320,000 kg of household batteries have been collected. In the last 17 years in Saskatchewan, 40,871 metric tonnes of end-of-life electronics have been collected and repurposed rather than trashed in landfills. Our local SARCAN depot and employees are on the front line of collecting these and many other items. I'm thankful for the services they provide for our community.

Challenges remain with our seemingly insatiable consumption patterns. Food scraps and waste, textile waste, marine and micro plastic waste, the common "forever" chemicals called PFAS, and so-on... Facing up to these daunting but doable challenges is one of our municipal responsibilities as it is for individuals, families, schools, businesses, scientists, and engineers.

# May Council Highlights

- Various existing policies were amended and adopted: Sask Lotteries Community Grant and Corporate Credit Card.
- One tender was received for the Town's 2024 & 2025 weed spraying requirements which was awarded to Rid-A-Weed.
- The Sask. Lotteries Community Grant for 2024-2025 in the amount of \$25,381.00 was allocated to 17 local groups.
- Council approved the following donations:

Group/Organization	Purpose	Amount
Rosthern Community School	Football Program	\$2,000.00
Rosthern Junior College	2024 RJC Golf Classic	\$100.00

- The Town sold the last residential lot in the cul-de-sac of Wheatland Court.
- All the Valley Aquatic Centre's staff has been hired for the 2024 swimming season.
- Two summer students were hired for the Municipal Operations positions. The remaining student will be starting July 2, 2024.
- The first reading to amend the Official Community Plan and Zoning Bylaw No. 2008-08 to rezone an area north of the Sask Valley Medical Clinic from FUD- Future Urban Development to R2 - Medium Density Residential was passed. The second and third readings are to take place after the Public Hearing advertised for June 3, 2024.
- The Bylaw 2024-03 Water & Sewer Infrastructure Fees to increase water, sewer, and infrastructure fee amounts have been approved by Council and the Saskatchewan Municipal Board. These small three-year increases will provide funding for a near future water and sewer project.
- The Bylaw 2024-04 Mill Rate Factor & Base Tax was approved. The previous months budget information noted the increases.
- The Town and RM of Rosthern No.403 has hired a permanent Fire Chief, Bill Doran who started May 23, 2024. We thank our past Fire Chief, Darcy Hrycuik for his contribution in this role. Darcy will be staying on the Fire and Rescue department as a member to provide his knowledge and experience.
- The Town has extended a one-year contract with Greenwave Energy Services at a cost of \$5,600.00. This contract provides monitoring of our Jubilee Sports Centre's power and energy needs to help us reduce the operational costs.
- The sidewalk tender for 4th Street has been awarded to MY-T Bobcatting Services at the price of \$96,285.00. Work has started in this area.
- June is National Parks & Recreation Month! The Town's Recreation Department will be hosting different activities throughout the month to observe this.
