# October Council Highlights

- Council awarded the Water Treatment Plant and Well Upgrade Project tender to Con-Tech General Contractors at a base bid price of \$11,873,429 plus tax. Construction will start on the new Water Treatment Plant building and reservoir in spring of 2025. The Well Upgrade portion of the project has been stalled due to a right of entry agreement and right of way easement. The Town was approved for a grant through the Investing IN Canada Infrastructure Program in the amount of up to 72% of the project, up to \$14,109,379. This funding is provided by Federal and Provincial grant dollars.
- Council approved the following donations:
  - Wheatkings Senior hockey Club, 2024-25 Annual Sponsorship, \$ 1, 000.00
  - Rosthern Minor Hockey, Ice Wars, November 30, 2024, \$500.00
  - Valley Action Abilities, Annual Fundraising Event - November 7, 2024, \$600.00
  - Rosthern Senior Citizens Club, Annual Christmas Dinner Event, December 12, 2024, \$100.00
- The temporary position for the Finance Manager has been extended to November 1, 2024.
- Zani Aye was hired as a full-time seasonal Recreation Operator for the 2024-25 JSC season
- Council approved Landon Riekman to offer skate sharpening for the 2024-25 JSC season. Days and times will be determined by the contractor.
- Four new member applications for the Rosthern Fire & Rescue have been approved by Council.
- Free Transit service will be offered on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, for voting in the Municipal Election at the Community Multi-purpose Centre. If you require a ride to vote, please call (306) 232-7319. This service will be from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- A Public Works Update:
  - The annual asphalt fogging maintenance program was completed on twelve blocks. This oil mixture is spread on existing pavement to prolong the life of existing pavement.
  - The annual raw water line annual swabbing has been completed along with annual line flushing and all irrigation systems have been winterized.
  - Crushing of cement at the transfer station is scheduled for winter of 2024
