Muriel's tree is planted in honor of Richard St. Barbe Baker. The accomplishments of this amazing person can be read about in Man of the Trees... The First Global Conservationist.

English born St. Barbe Baker started his career near Beaver Creek and worked on reforestation around the world. Days before his death in 1982, he planted his last tree on the grounds of the University of Saskatchewan. He is buried in Woodlawn cemetery in Saskatoon.

Fire Prevention Week October 6 to 12

- Smoke alarms alert you to a fire in time for you to escape, even if you are sleeping.
- Install alarms on every level of your home, outside each sleeping area and in each sleeping room
- We recommend sleeping with your door closed
- Test each alarm every month and replace batteries once a year, or whenever an alarm "chirps" to signal a low battery
- Newer units with the 10-year long-life batteries, should also be tested monthly
- Never "borrow" a smoke alarm battery for another use - a disabled alarm can't save your life. Replace alarms that are more than ten years old.

Grass Clippings
Garden Waste, Leaves and Weeds
Fruit and Vegetable Waste
Sawdust, Coffee Grounds and Filters
Tea Bags
Egg Shells
Branches - Must be in 3 - foot lengths
Compost materials may be placed in containers or plastic bags (do not tie) and must be at the curb **prior to 7:00 a.m.** Containers weighing over 50 pounds will **NOT** be picked up
