There are sounds that repeat yearly. Sometimes they're reassuring and welcomed, sometimes not so much! Three of my summer favorites:

Centennial Park sounds: Sounds of the bat and ball, team enthusiasm, splashing, playful swimmers in the Valley Aquatic Centre along with the sound system putting out beat and rhythm, sometimes even a familiar tune!

Sounds of birds: Birds heard and/or seen were listed by myself and 5 others in May. This year we identified 152 species of birds in and around town. In comparison, last year we listed 163 species. 15 different birds were identified this year which were not seen or heard in 2023. This year's bird list is available by contacting the Town Office.

Sounds of work: The sound of an air-nailer installing new shingles, the sound of the street sweeper, even the sound of a lawn being mowed...

Property improvements and municipal maintenance sounds indicate a community that is valued and well cared for.

While summer continues, even with sometimes troubling sounds, here's wishing you all the summer sounds of reassurance and comfort.

Fire Safety Tips from the Fire Department



Fire Extinguisher Know How's

- Every house should have a functioning ABC-rated fire extinguisher, stored in an easily accessible spot. There may not be time to read the instructions before tackling the flames, so it's important that you understand how to properly use the extinguisher before an emergency occurs. Remember the PASS acronym:
 - Pull the pin
 - Aim the nozzle at the base of the fire
 - Squeeze the trigger
 - Sweep the extinguisher from side to side
- Fire extinguishers should only be used when the fire is small and contained - for a large fire call 911 for help.

July Council Highlights

- Council approved a \$2,000.00 sponsorship for the Rosthern Junior College for 2024.
- The Town of Rosthern has entered into an agreement with the Towns of Hepburn, Waldheim, Duck Lake, and the RM of Rosthern No.403 to establish the Twin Rivers Community Safety Officer Program. You will see our Community Safety Officer program roll out within the coming month.
- The Municipal Operations Manager presented the 2023 annual drinking water quality and compliance report to Council. This report is available for public viewing at www.rosthern.com or interested parties can contact the Town Office for a copy.
- Council has approved the setup of two mobile food vendors: one vendor for a special event and the other to setup in Centennial Park and various other Town-owned areas.
- The Town had approved, in partnership with the RM of Rosthern No.403, the Rosthern Fire & Rescue Department to purchase new personal protection equipment (PPE) and safety equipment to replace aging PPE and equipment.
- Approval has been given to Taxervice to proceed with the issuance of 6-month notices to affected property owners. After 6 months, the proceedings to transfer the title to the Town will occur as authorized through the *Tax Enforcement Act*.
- The Town has cancelled the tender for the new Water Wells Hookup project due to receiving bids which is over budget. This tender will be tendered again in the future.
- Council has approved the sale price of the two remaining Town-owned lots in the trailer court for \$20,000.00 each plus GST. If you are interested, please contact the Town Office for details.

Compost materials may be placed in containers or plastic bags (do not tie) and must be at the curb **prior to 7:00 a.m.** Containers weighing over 50 pounds will **NOT** be picked up

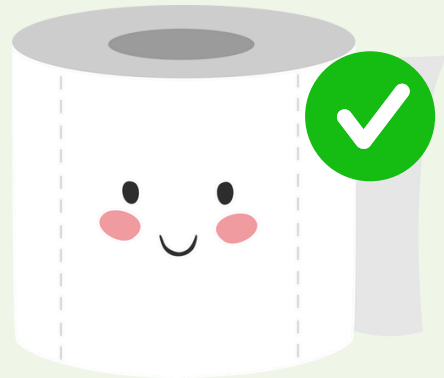

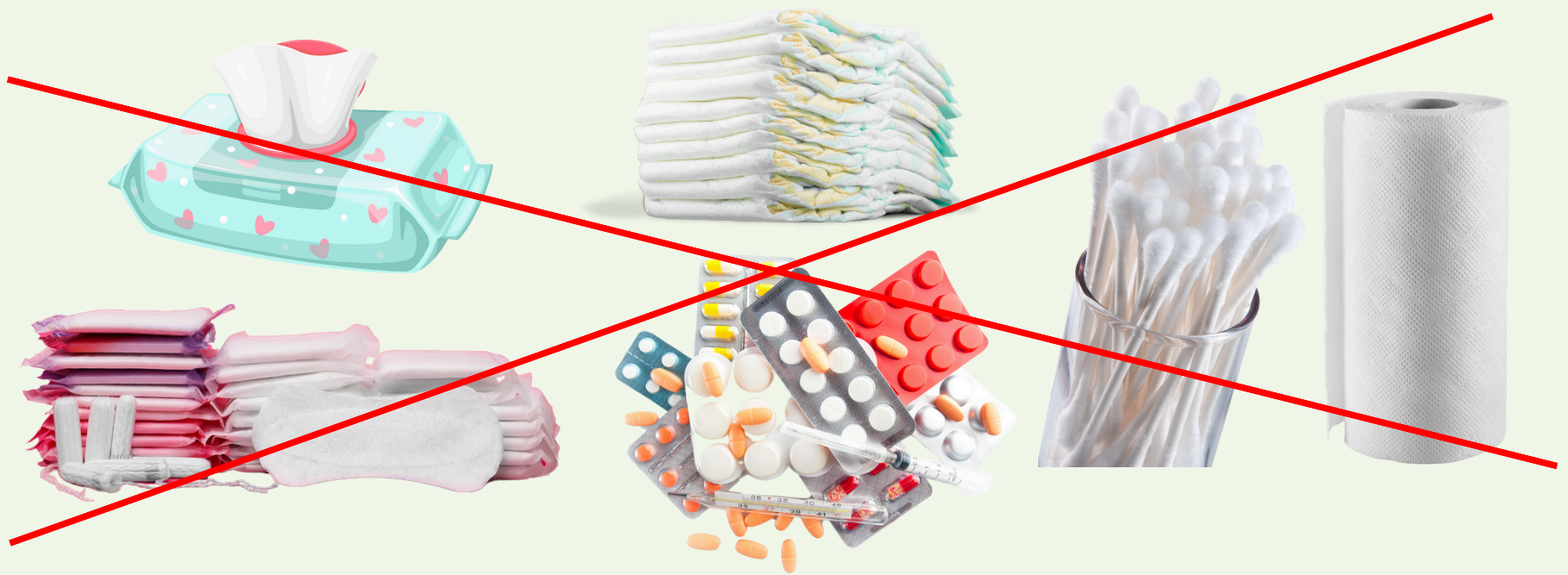
