## Fire Safety Tips from the Fire Department

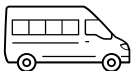
Follow these fire safety tips to prevent cooking emergencies from happening to you:

- Stay in the kitchen while you are cooking. If you leave the kitchen for even a short period of time, turn off the stove. The leading cause of a kitchen fire is unattended cooking.
- If you are simmering, baking, or roasting, check it regularly. Use a timer to remind you if needed
- Keep anything that can catch fire like oven mitts, wooden utensils, food packaging and towels away from your stovetop.
- Cover an oil fire with a lid or use a fire extinguisher. Never attempt to extinguish a cooking oil fire with water.

- Tea Bags
- Egg Shells
- Branches - Must be in 3 - foot lengths

Compost materials may be placed in containers or plastic bags (do not tie) and must be at the curb **prior to 7:00 a.m.** Containers weighing over 50 pounds will **NOT** be picked up
