Service Line Warranties of Canada

The Town of Rosthern has partnered with Service Line Warranties of Canada (SLWC), an independent company, to offer eligible homeowners **Optional** repair plans which can help protect residents against potentially expensive emergency repairs to water/well service lines or sewer/septic lines on their private property. The partnership with SLWC provides a way to increase a homeowners' awareness of their responsibility for these costs, while offering an optional solution for those who like to participate.

Plans Available in the Town of Rosthern:

- Exterior Water Service Line coverage - **\$7.55** per month plus any applicable taxes.
- Exterior Sewer/Septic Line coverage - **\$9.55** per month plus any applicable taxes

February Council Highlights

- Council approved sponsoring the Rosthern Lions Pasta Night Fundraiser in the amount of \$500.00.
- Fire Services Bylaw 2025-02 has been passed, resulting in adoption of fire prevention measures, including the enforcement of codes and standards to keep our community safe.
- Kate Chytyk has been hired as the Term Finance Clerk starting April 1, 2025, with a starting wage of \$20.91.
- The Town has applied for the SGI Provincial Traffic Safety Grant to replace and add flashing beacon systems and stop signs at identified high traffic intersections around our community.
- Budget meetings have been ongoing with the final budget expected to be passed by April 11, 2025.
- Council has denied the discretionary use application for transloading site on Railway Avenue East.
- A one-year tax exemption in accordance with the Town's commercial tax incentive policy was approved.
