

July Council Highlights

- The Town has put in an offer to purchase the lands legally described as Lot 26, Block 6, Plan 101692818 and Lot 5, Block 6, Plan D1000 for future opportunity for commercial development.
- Council respectfully declined an offer from 2335321 Alberta Ltd. to purchase Parcel XX. The decision supports the Town's long-term planning and strategic land use goals for this parcel.
- The Town has entered into a new four-year lease and grant agreement with the Station Arts Centre. This partnership will support continued arts, culture, and community programming in Rosthern.
- The Town has issued a request for proposals to developers for residential development just north of the Sask Valley Healthcare Clinic, to address future growth and residential housing needs.
- Council adopted the budget process policy.
- Council has submitted a letter of support - coordinated by SREDA and regional partners - asking the province to update *The Vehicles for Hire Act*. The proposed changes would allow future ride-sharing services to operate in Rosthern under a province-wide licensing model if approved.
- Cory Deptuch has been appointed as interim Fire Chief effective July 1st and will serve in the role until a permanent Fire Chief is hired.
- Water Treatment Plant Construction - Community Update**
- The Town Council acknowledges recent concerns from residents near the Water Treatment Plant construction site regarding noise, environmental elements, early start times, and weekend work.
- While we understand the disruption it may cause, this infrastructure project is **critical** to Rosthern's long-term growth, future service capacity and fire suppression services. Town Administration, in collaboration with our Engineers and the Contractor, are reviewing construction schedules and bylaw compliance to ensure work is carried out respectfully and within regulated hours as best to our ability.
