# June Council Highlights

- Several summer seasonal positions were filled for the Valley Aquatic Centre.
- Council awarded the 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue sidewalk replacement tender, as per recommendation by Consulting Engineers, Catterall & Wright, to MY-T Bobcatting Services Ltd. at a base bid price of \$75,684 with an additional 15% construction contingency. Each year, the Town selects a designated area of sidewalk for renewal as part of its ongoing initiative to methodically address replacement needs.
- Spring Hockey concluded in mid-May, and the Jubilee Sports Centre has since been thoroughly cleaned and readied for the 2025-2026 season.
- The Rosthern Ball Diamonds are on peak activity for the season, with numerous tournaments having taken place since mid-May. Council has approved a request from the Valley Vipers to utilize the designated open space at the end of 10<sup>th</sup> Street for tournament dates July 11 - 13 and July 16 - 18, 2025 to accommodate camping for participating players, as needed.
- A bylaw authorizing debt in the amount of \$474,362 has been approved to finance the acquisition of a new multi-functional wheel loader.
- Todd Hanson was hired as a Casual Librarian, with the position starting on June 2, 2025
- In response to the early June wildfires, the Town generously offered free swimming at the Valley Aquatic Centre to those affected. This initiative extended not only to the individuals at the three local evacuee centres, but also to individuals staying privately with family or friends within Town limits.
- Council has accepted, with sincere regret, the resignation of Bill Doran from his role as Fire Chief of Rosthern Fire and Rescue. Though he served for only a year, Bill made a significant and lasting impact on the department's future.
- The Municipal Operations department is well underway in its seasonal maintenance activities across the community. Crews are hard at work ensuring public spaces and infrastructure are in top shape for the months ahead:

- street sweeping,
- well, water line flushing, and hydrant flushing,
- line and crosswalk painting,
- cleaning catch basins,
- grading and dust control,
- road repairs,
- servicing all pumps at well houses and sewer lift stations,
- mowing and walking trail maintenance,
- ongoing preparation at our ball diamonds, and Aquatic Centre,
- ongoing maintenance in green spaces, municipal reserve areas, cemeteries,
- and so much more.
