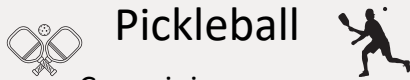

October Council Highlights

- In November, Council members will attend the Saskatchewan Urban Municipalities Association (SUMA) Northwest Regional Meeting in Shellbrook, SK. This event supports collaboration and knowledge-sharing among municipal leaders.
- Council has officially acknowledged the List of Lands in Arrears. This is part of the Municipality's regular financial oversight and property tax process.
- Council has submitted an infrastructure investment plan to extend 4th Street as part of the Canada Community-Building Fund. This road extension will support a new housing development and is a required step to qualify for the funding program.
- Tyler Roth has been hired as the Public Works Lead Hand starting October 20, 2025, with the wage of \$36.44 per hour
- Dan Vercaemmen has been hired as a Municipal Operator starting November 3, 2025, with the wage of \$28.74 per hour.
- Jayme Lachance has been hired as the Seasonal Recreation Labourer for the term of October 20, 2025, to April 30, 2026, with the wage of \$20.49 per hour. This annual position accommodates seasonal programming at the Jubilee Sports Centre.
- Council has accepted, with regret, the resignation of Guylaine Green as the Twin Rivers District Administrator. The position has now been posted and recruitment is underway.

- Council has approved moving the Regular Council and Committee of the Whole meetings from December 8 to December 15, 2025. Meeting times will remain the same.
