About 40 residents heard presentations, conversation, and asked questions. The recent film "Reserve 107, the path forward" was shown. This is the on-going story of the Young Chippewyan band/ Stoney Knoll First Nation as they work with Mennonites and Lutherans to right the wrongs of the past. Stony Hill or Stony Knoll is located just West of Laird. This is another example close to home of the complex and shared past and the reconciliation work that I think is important for us to be part of. To this end, what is your story about the Truth and Reconciliation journey?

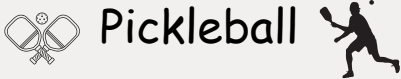

September Council Highlights

- Council has reviewed and adopted the 2024 Municipal Water Works Report. This report shows how our water system is managed, including costs and revenues, to ensure transparency, sustainability, and compliance with provincial regulations.
- The Town has given RFNOW Inc. permission to proceed with the installation of underground fibre optic cable along the east side of Highway 11 through the Town boundaries. RFNOW's project is building connectivity to 80+ communities within Saskatchewan.
- The Town has renewed our agreement with the City of Saskatoon and nine other municipalities to continue to hire an Emergency Management coordinator. This position assists in the creation of the Town's emerging management plans, which are legislated by the province and coordinates emergency response in the event of a massive incident.
- Council approved extending the Jubilee Sports Centre's 2025-2026 operational season to April 30, 2026, to accommodate spring hockey events.
- The Town has put in another offer to purchase the lands legally described as Lot 26, Block 6, Plan 101692818 and Lot 5, Block 6, Plan D1000 for future opportunity for commercial development.
- Lucius Martens has been approved as a Member of the Rosthern Fire and Rescue department.
- The Town has completed sewer relining on four blocks of 4th Street, from 4th Avenue to Railway Avenue. This modern method is more cost-effective, less disruptive than traditional trenching, and offers the same long-lasting durability as conventional replacement.
