August Council Highlights

- Nicholas Elder was hired as a seasonal summer labourer starting July 24 to August 29, 2025.
- As part of the second intake of the Town's Donation and Grant Policy, Good Neighbours Food Centre received \$500.00 in support of their vital food security program.
- The Station Arts Centre was approved to serve liquor at the Jubilee Sports Centre during the Harvest Festival on September 19 and 20, 2025.
- Mayor Helmuth attended the SUMA Mayors' Summer School speaking about Twin Rivers District regional cooperation.
- The Town has hired Brianna Lock Photography to refresh Council, and staff photos to update our website.
- Aylawynn Lehmann has been approved as a Junior Member of the Rosthern Fire and Rescue department
- As a trial, Council approved painting parking spots on both sides of 1st Avenue between 5th and 6th Street to help improve traffic flow and organization
- The Town, along with the Sask Valley Health Foundation, will be attending a Family Medicine Residents career fair hosted by SHA to promote our community to future family physicians.

Update on New Water Treatment Plant Project:

- Phase 1:** The plant construction is progressing steadily. Construction is over 50% complete on a below-grade, multi-chamber concrete reservoir that will store treated water and serve as the facility's foundation. Once complete, the reservoir will increase our treated water capacity from 221, 000 to well over 750, 000 gallons.
- Phase 2:** The new, larger raw water supply line on the east side of Highway 11 is delayed due to pending permit approvals. Approximately 2.2 kms of larger raw water supply line alongside the existing water supply line will be installed, from the Water Treatment Plant to the termination point near Highway 11 and 312, to facilitate water flows to the plant.
- Phase 3:** Construction of 5 new water wells is in the exploratory stage. The Town is also working on securing a road easement for the new supply line as part of the project.
